5. Juveniles should present themselves with their birds at the start of judging

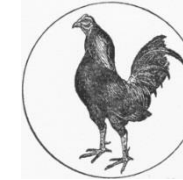
**We are also glad of any help you can offer after the show – taking down pens, putting away the tables, collecting water containers, pen numbers, sweeping up the shavings etc.**
